Task/ Process : Changing rooms (Showers)	People at Risk : Employees, Contractors, Members of the Public	

Hazard : Infection Hygiene related issues
Control Measures:
1. Cleanliness of Toilet and shower block is checked on a regular basis.

Hazard : Electrical Persons could suffer electrocution or burns from faulty appliances or fixed installation
Control Measures:
1. Fixed electrical installation tested and inspected every five years by competent electrician

Hazard : Hazardous Substances Risk of illness or skin conditions as a result of using or handling hazardous substances.
Control Measures:
1. Staff using cleaning equipment to manage spills and minor cleaning tasks are briefed on COSH procedures.
2. All hazardous substances are stored in a locked store room, except when in use. Staff monitor access to these products when in use. The centre maintains a list of all products, with material safety data sheets and COSHH risk assessments if required.

Hazard : Slips, Trips or Falls Persons slipping on spillage, tripping on objects or staircase and falling causing injury.
Control Measures:
1. There is adequate lighting throughout the area
2. Cleaning products have been selected to clean and not create slippery surfaces. The areas are not over cleaned - (over cleaning can create slip hazards)

Hazard : Fire Members suffer injury or death from fire.
Control Measures:
1. A separate Fire Risk Assessment is completed.

Hazard : Infection Persons suffer illness from the ingestion of faulty food stuffs, fluids, or come into contact with bacterial/waste products. i.e. contact with bacterial contaminants through hand touch of surfaces.

Control Measures:
1. The facilities and equipment are regularly cleaned by staff using decontaminant products.
2. The facilities are checked for cleanliness by staff regularly throughout the day and on completion of the shift.
3. The water source is checked and free from disease, legionella control measures are in place.
